

Good Afternoon Brian,
Here is our report for this month.

Crimes

Burglary

This **BURGLARY** took place between 2100hrs on Saturday 27th February and 0900hrs on Sunday 28th February at Charlton, Hartlebury. The victim has awoken to find damage done to a glass pane in the front door. Something was heard at 0300hrs, but nothing was seen. No access was gained, and although the garage was unsecured this was not entered.

Burglary

This **BURGLARY** took place in daylight hours on Thursday 3rd March on Station Road, Hartlebury. At this time POPUK have entered an open, unsecured garage and removed items. These included an EKO long handled Hedge Trimmer with Pole Saw attachment and a Boxed STIHL Disc Cutter.

Burglary

This **BURGLARY** was discovered at 0945hrs on Thursday 10th March at Charlton, Hartlebury. At this time it was discovered that POPUK had broken into a vacant property. They had moved boxes around and stolen some paraquet flooring. It appeared that they had broken through an internal door from the garage.

Criminal Damage/Arson

This **CRIMINAL DAMAGE/ARSON** took place between 1800hrs on Friday 11th March and 1200hrs on Monday 14th March on Chadwick Lane, Hartlebury. Between these times, POPUK have set fire to a single portaloo in an isolated field, causing approximately £500 of damage.

Burglary

This **BURGLARY** took place between 2300hrs on Monday 21st March and 0615hrs on Tuesday 22nd March on Worcester Road, Torton. Between these times POPUK have bent the rods on a gate to gain entry to property grounds and have gained access to three garages. Items stolen include a Mountain bike, 2 Stihl Strimmers, a Dewalt Driver, a Dewalt Replicating Saw and a Stihl Leaf Blower. Approximately £1000 of damage was done to the gate.

Burglary

This **BURGLARY** took place between 0100hrs and 0245hrs on Tuesday 22nd March on Worcester Road, Torton.

Between these times, 4 unknown males have cut through a fence and forced entry to a garage. Items Stolen include Belle whacker plate in grey and orange value £800

JCB concrete breaker white and yellow £500, KTM kids motorcycle £400, Ryobi chainsaw in blue £100, Paslode nail gun in a orange box x2 £400 each, Top Con laser level in beige carry case £800, Makita saw x2 £250 and £100, Bosch 2x electrical drill £120 each, Bosch jigsaw £120, Makita electrical brick saw £600, Mitre saw in silver £150, Petrol jet washer in black £200 and aPaddle mixer in grey £150. Also stolen out of a unlocked van parked nearby was a Ryobi cordless drill £150.

There was cctv at the scene and investigations are ongoing.

Criminal Damage

This **CRIMINAL DAMAGE** took place between Sunday 20th March and Tuesday 22nd March on Crown Lane, Waresley.

Between these times POPUK have done damage by cutting the cable on a telegraph pole. The approximate value of the damage is £200.

Burglary

This **BURGLARY** took place between 1730hrs on Tuesday 22nd March and 0830hrs on Wednesday 23rd March at Hartlebury Castle.

Between these times 4 unknown men have cut the padlock off the gate and entered the site. Nothing was stolen. There is CCTV and enquiries are ongoing.

At the same time, a property on the site has had a padlock cut and a garage entered. Nothing was stolen.

Burglary

This **BURGLARY** took place at 0140hrs on Thursday 24th March on Stourport Road, Hartlebury.

At this time, there has been an attempt to break into a garage. The bolt has been cut but the offenders have not gained access. They have been disturbed by the victim and officers have attended the area but there was no trace.

Given the incidents that have occurred, we would recommend all residents to do their best to ensure that any outbuildings are secured and to report any suspicious vehicles. This would especially go for any vans or large vehicles seen late at night.
