### **Highways Matters-**

#### **Bank House Inn Lane-**

I have asked Dave Hunter to have a look outside this house. There is no proper gutter in the road and so all rain water goes under the raised pavement area, which has now started to sink in certain places. The Owner of Bank House has been trying to get somewhere with it for a while but Dave Hunter informs me that Highways have booked a time slot in the programme for September this year to undertake work at this location. They still need to do a full survey at this location to determine the exact work that they'll undertake, but it will probably involve the installation of a concrete gutter. He will come back to me with further details in due course.

#### **Footpath on A4025-**

I have emailed Dave Hunter about the Mitre Oak end of this path. The hedging is overhanging the path badly and in one place a few big bushes are now blocking it. Residents are having to step out into the road to get round it. I have received a phone call about it so have raised it with Dave Hunter.
