

## Hartlebury Parish Hall Management Committee Meeting: Tuesday 15 June 2016

### Summary

- There are four new Trustees of the Committee and therefore a full compliment. The current Officers of the Committee have been re-elected for a further year but, due to the constitution, this will have to be their last year in office.
- A new bar sub-committee has been elected. The bar is being managed effectively and the new license is in place. All Trustees will be undergoing Challenge 25 training (re. underage sales) to comply with the conditions of the new license.
- A fund raising / events sub-committee has also been elected. The arrangement the Committee had with the event organising company Shindig was not particularly successful in attracting people to the venue but all events made a small profit so the sub-committee is considering whether to renew its contract. It is also considering whether to arrange an ABBA tribute night at the hall.... watch this space!
- The hall and its facilities are still being booked regularly, although there is a seasonal dip during July.
- The finances are in a healthy state.
- The Committee is keen to send a representative to the Playing Fields Steering Group once it has been set up.
