Title	HLTC Electricity Supply
Background	<p>A few months ago, the Parish Council took responsibility for the club. Since then, despite no power being consumed, the electricity supply has been maintained.</p> <p>With no immediate prospect of power being required, consideration should be given to minimizing electricity costs.</p>
Considerations	<p>We are currently on a Direct Debit scheme with Npower paying £65/month when consuming no electricity. Having taken a meter reading, we will be getting a refund of about £176 and the DD payment will be reduced to about £10/month.</p> <p>I have further spoken to the contracts people and we have two options; firstly to carry on as at present on a non-contract basis paying just the standing charge of about £23/quarter (hence the £10/month DD), assuming we use no power. Alternatively we could terminate the supply completely (at a cost of about £28) and then, when power is again required, re-negotiate a contract with Npower or some other supplier. With Npower the cost of re-instating the supply will be zero.</p>
Proposals	To terminate the supply pro tem at a cost of about £28.
