The speed data has now been collected from Rectory Lane and Old Worcester Road.

As regards Rectory Lane in the vicinity of the school speeds obtained were in the 35/36mph range and traffic volumes also meet the criteria for the Safer Roads Partnership.I understand that enforcement is now under consideration providing a suitable location can be found for one of our vehicles to park.

As regards Old Worcester Road speeds were in excess of 35mph but traffic volumes were low and currently do not meet the Safer Roads Partnership enforcement criteria.The Local Policing Team will be requested to assist at this location.
