

## Police Report April 2016

### Criminal Damage

This **CRIMINAL DAMAGE** took place between 1700hrs on Monday 4th April and 0800hrs on Tuesday 5th April on Hillditch Lane, Hartlebury.

Between these times, POPUK have cut the lock off a gate and gained entry to a field. They have then used a vehicle to destroy the gate and a horse shed.

### Burglary

This **BURGLARY** was discovered at 1020 on Tuesday 5th April on Parsons Lane, Chadwick Bank.

At this time it was discovered that POPUK broken through a concrete wall into a barn. Nothing was stolen but the cost of the damage is £300-£400.

### Burglary

This **BURGLARY** took place at 0115hrs on Thursday 7th April at The Village, Hartlebury.

At this time, POPUK have forced entry to a shed and a garage. They have been disturbed by an alarm activating and nothing was stolen.

### Criminal Damage

This **CRIMINAL DAMAGE** took place between 1830hrs on Sunday 10th April and 0715hrs on Monday 11th April on Lincomb Lane, Titton.

Between these times, POPUK have caused damage to the bottom half of a gate, to the value of approximately £200.

### Vehicle Crime

This **VEHICLE CRIME** took place Overnight between Saturday 16th April and Sunday 17th April on Worcester Road, Hartlebury.

Between these times, POPUK have forced the rear tail gate and gained entry to a vehicle parked on a driveway. They have stolen 5 Stihl Petrol chainsaws.

### Vehicle Crime

This **VEHICLE CRIME** took place Overnight between Monday 18th April and Tuesday 19th April at Bishops Wood Environmental Centre, Crossway Green.

Between these times, POPUK have cut a padlock to gain entry to the yard. They have then stolen a Mercedes Sprinter Mini Bus. This was later found burnt out on Hartlebury Common, along with another vehicle.

There have also been issues with fly-tipping around the Chadwick Bank area. We are working in partnership with the council to try and counter this.

There is also an incident that may be of interest to Andy Murcott. On the night of the 21st, there was what is believed to be an electrical fire at a Junction box. It is possible that this also caused some damage to a nearby BT box. This may have been related to the subsequent issue with the phone lines. There were no other issues reported.
