

Police Report – August 2016

This **BURGLARY DWELLING** took place between **23:30:00** on **TUESDAY 26-JUL-2016** and **10:30:00** on **WEDNESDAY 27-JUL-2016** at **CARPENTERS FARM, WORCESTER RD, LOW HILL, KIDDERMINSTER, WORCESTERSHIRE**

Between said time and date, unknown offender(s) have approached secure and attended property which is situated on a busy road. Offender(s) have then used an unknown implement to jimmy one of the ground floor windows to gain access to a ground floor room. When inside the offender(s) have conducted a tidy search of the room and left via way entered making good escape. Items stolen include a Sky box , 3 x Gas compressed hand guns, Walkie Talkies, an IPHONE 6, 3 x PSP games, an APPLE laptop, a HEWLETT PACKARD laptop, a NINTENDO 3DS and approximately £1200 in cash.

This **THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE** took place between **23:55:00** on **FRIDAY 29-JUL-2016** and **00:02:00** on **SATURDAY 30-JUL-2016** at **MC POTATOES THE FARMHOUSE, BISHOPSWOOD RD, CROSSWAY GREEN, STOURPORT ON SEVERN, WORCESTERSHIRE**

During the times and dates stipulated a vehicle has driven onto the Potatoes Factory Site of which the gates were open. The vehicle is believed to be silver possibly a Volvo either estate or hatchback unknown VRM, containing two occupants in the vehicle. The vehicle has then reversed alongside the attacked Leyland Daf lorry and by unknown means/instrument approximately 3/4 tank of diesel is removed from the attacked vehicle without causing any damage, although the fuel cap was lockable. The vehicle has then left the site

This **BURGLARY-OUTBUILDING** took place between **13:00:00** on **MONDAY 01-AUG-2016** and **15:31:00** on **MONDAY 01-AUG-2016** at **NORCHARD, STOURPORT ON SEVERN, WORCESTERSHIRE, DY13 9SN**

During the times and date stipulated POPU have used unknown means/instrument to damage the side door to a garage which is separate from the dwelling, no integral door leading into the dwelling, the garage is approximately 10 metres from the dwelling. Entry has been gained and a further internal door within the garage which is secured with a combination lock has been stolen and various items have been removed from this further area of the garage, including a lawnmower, combi tools and several remote control helicopters which are rare and can be identified.

This **THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE** took place between **19:00:00** on **MONDAY 01-AUG-2016** and **07:40:00** on **TUESDAY 02-AUG-2016** at **TRAVELODGE, CROSSWAY GREEN, STOURPORT ON SEVERN, WORCESTERSHIRE, DY13 9SH**

Location is car park of Travel Lodge Hotel, during material times, unknown offender(s) have entered the open car park and approached a Black Renault Panel Van. Using an unknown implement, they have cut a 4inch square hole around the rear doors locking mechanism released the door handle, gained entry inside the vehicle, stolen and removed power tools from within. These

include a Bosch GLL2 Laser Level, a blue Bosch SDS Battery Drill 18Vol, a Red Hilti Laser Range Finder, a yellow Dewalt SDS Hammer Drill 110Volt, a Bosch 110 volt - Blue Hammer Drill, a White and Red striped Leica Level in Red Box

This **ATTEMPT THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE** took place between **23:00:00** on **MONDAY 01-AUG-2016** and **07:00:00** on **TUESDAY 02-AUG-2016** at **TRAVELODGE, CROSSWAY GREEN, STOURPORT ON SEVERN, WORCESTERSHIRE, DY13 9SH**

Between times stated, u/k offenders came onto the Travel lodge car park and using an u/k implement cut a hole around the rear lock of the victim's van. Offenders didn't manage to gain access as the door was padlocked but damaged the rear door. Offenders made off in u/k direction by u/k means

This **THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE** took place between **22:00:00** on **MONDAY 01-AUG-2016** and **08:00:00** on **TUESDAY 02-AUG-2016** at **TRAVELODGE, CROSSWAY GREEN, STOURPORT ON SEVERN, WORCESTERSHIRE, DY13 9SH**

IP and her husband were staying at the Hartlebury Travelodge overnight and left their vehicle, a red Mitsubishi parked in the car park there. POPUK have jemmed the lock on the rear glass door and stolen a bag containing clothing and £500 in cash from the rear

This **THEFT** took place between **22:10:00** on **FRIDAY 05-AUG-2016** and **22:20:00** on **FRIDAY 05-AUG-2016** at **WARESLEY COURT RD, HARTLEBURY, KIDDERMINSTER, WORCESTERSHIRE**

Victim lives in a detached bungalow in a side road in a residential area with a 3ft high x 6 ft wide wooden fence at the front. Victim has CCTV which shows an unidentified van pull up with its lights off, reverse up the road putting lights back on to where the village hall carpark is. Two unidentifiable figures can be seen between the material time to remove x 8 of the 10 fence panels. CCTV shows the times but not good enough to identify either the figures or the vehicle

This **BURGLARY- OUTBUILDING** took place between **07:00:00** on **WEDNESDAY 03-AUG-2016** and **07:30:00** on **WEDNESDAY 03-AUG-2016** at **CHARLTON, HARTLEBURY, KIDDERMINSTER, WORCESTERSHIRE, DY11 7YE**
The offence took place in a rural area of Kidderminster. Between the material times, unknown offender(s) has entered an insecure barn where they have found an old Acorn stairlift. Offender(s) have picked this stairlift up and have taken it with them when they left the scene, leaving no trace of the property behind

This **ATTEMPT BURGLARY DWELLING** took place between **15:15:00** on **TUESDAY 09-AUG-2016** and **15:28:00** on **TUESDAY 09-AUG-2016** at **WORCESTER RD, WARESLEY, KIDDERMINSTER, WORCESTERSHIRE**

On Tuesday 9th August 2016 between 15:15 and 15:28 persons unknown have been seen outside an address on Old Worcester Road, Hartlebury. The

premises is a large detached house in a semi rural area, it has a large driveway to the front. The occupants were away on holiday at the offence time, persons unknown were seen by a passer by to be forcing the front upvc door with a crow bar, they had a vehicle reversed up the drive and in front of the door, the passer by shouted at them and x 2 white males got in to the vehicle and drove away down the road towards Kidderminster. The vehicle was described as a black Audi, partial registration ND12 ***. Males described only as one big the other small, small male wearing dark clothing, larger male wearing a grey hooded top, both with dark hair. Officers attended the address and it was clearly visible that there were x 5 blunt tool marks down the lock side of the door and frame, the bottom of the door had been forced away about 3 inches, no entry gained

This **VEHICLE CRIME/ THEFT FROM VEHICLE** took place between **16:45:00** on **WEDNESDAY 10-AUG-2016** and **17:19:00** on **WEDNESDAY 10-AUG-2016** at **LOWER HEATH HARTLEBURY COMMON, TITTON, STOURPORT ON SEVERN, WORCESTERSHIRE**

Between 1645hours and 1719hours on 10/08/16 the IP parked her White Landrover Freelander on the carpark of Hartlebury Common, Hartlebury Road, Stourport. The vehicle was parked and secured when she has returned to her vehicle she has been informed that persons unknown had attempted to smash the drivers window causing damage but not breaking the window. There was another vehicle parked next to the IP's vehicle a white BMW X3, this had the drivers window smashed and a pair of Oakley Sunglasses (value approx £150) had been taken from the drivers door pocket

This **BURGLARY-OUTBUILDING** took place between **14:00:00** on **THURSDAY 11-AUG-2016** and **18:30:00** on **THURSDAY 11-AUG-2016** at **MANOR LA, WARESLEY, KIDDERMINSTER, WORCESTERSHIRE**

The property is a rural location. At the back of the property is access going through into a fishery which is owed by the victim. The back garden is quite long and has a detached garage which had an electric double door, damaged and would be quite heavy to try and lift. The garage is right next to a neighbouring property. To get into the front of the property is access through a gate. Between times stated Person(s) Unknown has gained access into the back garden where they have used unknown means and lifted the door to the double garage. Once inside the garage a thorough search has been conducted throughout where a quadbike has been taken out and dragged across to the field. Person(s) Unknown has then caused damage to the barrel of quadbike, and stripped some more items from off the quadbike, leaving the toolbox. A pit-bike has also been stolen from out the garage. Unsure whether anything has been stolen from out the garage at this state. The quadbike has been left abandoned in the fields, hidden from view

This **INTERFERENCE WITH MOTOR VEHICLE** took place between **21:00:00** on **FRIDAY 12-AUG-2016** and **11:30:00** on **SATURDAY 13-AUG-2016** at **CHARLTON, HARTLEBURY, KIDDERMINSTER, WORCESTERSHIRE**

Sometime overnight PUK have entered IP's vehicle by unknown means as IP left his car locked on his driveway and no sign of forced entry. The following morning IP found his car with the front passenger door ajar and the glove box open. Nothing stolen from the car however 3 bank cards, not belonging to IP were found in the front nearside footwell

This **THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE** took place between **19:00:00** on **FRIDAY 12-AUG-2016** and **07:00:00** on **SATURDAY 13-AUG-2016** at **CHURCH COTTAGE, THE VILLAGE, HARTLEBURY, WORCESTERSHIRE**

Between times stated Vehicle was parked securely on driveway. Whilst unattended Person(s) Unknown has gained access into the vehicle, no forced entry. Person(s) Unknown has then found a small pocket area underneath the steering wheel and has located a cardholder and stolen this with contents

This **BURGLARY-OUTBUILDING** took place between **22:30:00** on **MONDAY 15-AUG-2016** and **06:30:00** on **TUESDAY 16-AUG-2016** at **WORCESTER RD, SHENSTONE, KIDDERMINSTER,**

Between the stated times person/s unknown have approached the location which is a dwelling in rural setting over fields close to the property. They have gained access to the garden by damaging the fence. Once inside they have accessed 2 garages. The first garage is a brick one with electric door and offenders have used a crowbar or similar to force open the shutter and gain access. They have taken a Kawasaki Mule as detailed in property. The second garage was accessed by using bolt cutters or similar tool to access through the rear window. Once inside a variety of power tools have been taken. Offenders have then left down the main drive and caused damage to the entrance barrier as they exited. It is assumed that the Kawasaki Mule has caused the damage as it was pushed through the barrier. No CCTV at location, nothing seen or heard

This **BURGLARY-OUTBUILDING** took place between **18:00:00** on **TUESDAY 16-AUG-2016** and **09:00:00** on **WEDNESDAY 17-AUG-2016** at **DROITWICH RD, TORTON, KIDDERMINSTER, WORCESTERSHIRE**

Between the dates and times stated persons unknown have broken into an agricultural metal building which is located in a field next to a property on Droitwich Road Kidderminster. The building was secured with padlocks which were cut off and discarded. There is no cctv at the location. to the ip stated she feels that they have possibly been disturbed as there is nothing missing to their knowledge as yet they can see

This **INTERFERENCE WITH MOTOR VEHICLE** took place between **20:00:00** on **WEDNESDAY 17-AUG-2016** and **07:30:00** on **THURSDAY 18-AUG-2016** at **CROSSWAY GREEN, STOURPORT ON SEVERN, WORCESTERSHIRE**

During the times shown, popu have approached the victims white Fiat Scudo panel van which has been parked secure and unattended on the drive. Using an unknown tool or implement the offender has prized off the cover from around the hole of the lock and pushed the tool or implement into the lock

causing damage to the lock and allowing the door to open. Entry has been gained but nothing within the vehicle to take or nothing appears to have been disturbed

This **THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE** took place between **17:45:00** on **SATURDAY 20-AUG-2016** and **18:30:00** on **SATURDAY 20-AUG-2016** at **CARPARK, HARTLEBURY RD, STOURPORT ON SEVERN, WORCESTERSHIRE**

The victim has parked within a carpark, secured the vehicle, placing purse inside glove compartment secured the compartment and went and walked the dog. Between times stated Person(s) Unknown has used unknown means and smashed the front passenger window, gained access and stolen the purse from out of the glove compartment. Some of the paperwork from the glove compartment has been left on the passenger seat. Nothing else within the vehicle has been stolen

This **BURGLARY-BUILDING** took place between **16:30:00** on **FRIDAY 19-AUG-2016** and **08:30:00** on **MONDAY 22-AUG-2016** at **15, J C AUTO VALET, CHADWICK BANK INDUSTRIAL EST, CHADWICK BANK, STOURPORT ON SEVERN**

JC AUTOS is a garage situated on Chadwick industrial site, the site itself is a small compound in a rural location, its consisting of a number of corrugated metal units. The site is accessed via a main road, while the site is closed there are barriers preventing vehicles from accessing (gate put in place due to fly tippers dumping rubbish) The site backs onto fields and bushes. Between the times stated person unknown has accessed the site via the rear fields, once on the site they have cut the wire mesh to a window on a port cabin outside JC AUTOS main unit. Offender(s) have climbed into the cabin and conducted a tidy search, offenders have stolen a number of charity sweet bags and about £5 cash from the charity sweet box, 4 x cans of pop, 1 x box of Typhoo tea bags (Box of 80), 1 x packet of cup of soup (4 sachets in a box) and about £5 in loose change from a draw within the office

This **BURGLARY** took place at **10:30:00** on **SUNDAY 21-AUG-2016** at **HARTLEBURY PARISH HALL, WARESLEY COURT RD, HARTLEBURY, KIDDERMINSTER, WORCESTERSHIRE**

The premises is a large parish hall in a semi rural location, between 10:30 on Sunday 21st August 2016 and 10:30 22nd August 2016 persons unknown have used a blunt tool to force open a rear UPVC door, they have caused minimal damage but have entered as trespassers in to the main kitchen area. They had access to the entire building which they then forced open a further wooden door to allow them in to the bar area, a further door was also forced giving access behind the bar. A wooden double door was also forced in to a storage area where alcohol was stored, persons have then removed x 1 bottle of Vodka £20:00, x 1 bottle of Jack Daniels whiskey £25:00 and a multi pack of soft drinks £15:00. x 2 further storage cuboards were also forced open but no other items taken, offenders believed to have egressed as entry. Total cost of damage estimated to be £1,000 as doors will need replacing

This **THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE** took place between **16:06:00** on **WEDNESDAY 24-AUG-2016** and **17:06:00** on **WEDNESDAY 24-AUG-2016** at **LOWER HEATH HARTLEBURY COMMON, TITTON, STOURPORT ON SEVERN, WORCESTERSHIRE**

Between the times given the ip has parked her car in the car park at the location and has placed her handbag in the boot of the car under the dog bed before going for a walk. On her return the IP has found the rear window and driver's side rear window smashed and her handbag taken.

As you can see, there have been a number of issues in the area. Whilst I understand this will cause concern, I would like to highlight that a number of these have occurred on similar occasions and will be linked. We have strong intelligence suggesting who is involved and ourselves and Kidderminster are working closely to identify the offenders. We are also aware of the concerns raised about people raising along the A449.

In response to this patrols have been stepped up in the area between the Esso garage and the Black Bridge. We will also be trying to increase our presence within the village itself.

I would finally like to inform you that PC Rees has left our SNT to join Stourport as their temporary Sergeant. This will offer us great value as he will take his local knowledge there and work to target the offenders who commit crime across our borders.
