

Agenda 9(1) – Police Report

Burglary Outbuilding took place between 12 noon on Saturday 28 January 2017 and 17.00 on Wednesday 1 February 2017 at **Stoney Lane, Crossway Green, Stourport on Severn**

Victim is in the process of having a bungalow built at the rear of his detached house. The bungalow has a new drive to access it and in doing so can also access where the shed currently is. Victim will be getting the land divided in due course. Between the material times unknown person/s have accessed the rear garden via the new driveway and have used unknown means to force a strong lock off victim's shed. Entry has been gained and a red petrol lawnmower and a red Stihl hedge cutter have been stolen. The shed door was noticed open on 010217 by person/s who had come to work at the property and victim has realised what has happened at time of report. Stand alone canvas covered trailer also searched but nothing stolen.

Theft took place at 10.06 on Friday 10 February 2017 at **Waresley Court Road, Hartlebury**

At time stated, 2 unknown males wearing high visibility jackets have gone onto the IP's property and taken some metal items from behind the IP's car, which he was planning to weight in and sell. The 2 males were in a white Ford Transit, VRM unseen.

Criminal Damage took place between 16.00 on Saturday 11 February 2017 and 08.00 on Sunday 12 February 2017 at **Torton, Kidderminster**

Offenders unknown have approached a piece of land situated in a rural location, the land is surrounded by newly erected wire fencing with wooden posts, the perimeter of which is approx 1000 metres. Offenders have then by means unknown cut through the wire fencing and forced posts from the ground causing extensive damage. Offenders have also bent the gate and cut through the chain which was securing the gate. No witnesses, no suspects, no CCTV.

Theft of Motor Vehicle took place between 18.00 on Friday 17 February 2017 and 09.00 on Saturday 18 February 2017 at **Waterlaide Road, Hartlebury**

Between stated times, IP has parked up his blue Land Rover Discovery outside his home address leaving it secure and locked it up for the night. At approximately 09.00 on the 18 February he has come out of his home address and walked around to the front at which point he had discovered that the vehicle was not outside of the address and had been subsequently stolen. He is still in possession of both sets of keys and there was no debris left at the scene by the offenders.

Burglary Outbuilding took place between 11.45 on Friday 17 February 2017 and 14.50 on Saturday 18 February 2017 at **The Fishery, Titton, Stourport on Severn**

At date and time stated PUK have accessed the trout fisheries via adjacent land on Lincomb Nurseries. PUK have utilised a ladder to climb an 8ft steel fence which surrounds the fishery. Once inside the fishery compound PUK have gained entry to a secure caravan, an untidy search has been made and property has been removed from within. It is unclear how entry was gained to the caravan as the lock was not damaged. PUK have smashed all the windows on a Nissan Panel Van motor vehicle which was parked on site. Entry has been gained to two small sheds by damaging the padlocks, property has been removed from within. Egress from the fishery was by the same means as entry, a TV removed from the caravan was left by the ladder.
