Good Afternoon,

Here is the report for this month.

This **THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE** took place between **22:00:00** on **TUESDAY 26-SEP-2017** and **07:30:00** on **WEDNESDAY 27-SEP-2017** at **THE VILLAGE, HARTLEBURY, WORCESTERSHIRE**

Victim parked his blue Renault Master van on the driveway at his home address. The victim states the vehicle was left unlocked, and the ignition keys were inside. Between the material times, persons unknown gained entry to the vehicle and stole the same. It would appear the offenders drove the vehicle away, with the side door open, as the victim has found a number of items strewn over the road which leads to Stourport. He confirms the items have come from the back of his van

This **THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE** took place between **18:00:00** on **THURSDAY 28-SEP-2017** and **21:00:00** on **THURSDAY 28-SEP-2017** at **MILLRIDGE WAY, HARTLEBURY, KIDDERMINSTER, WORCESTERSHIRE**

Between times stated Shineray motorcycle was left insecure & unattended within the front garden of a dwelling situated within a semi rural area of Hartlebury in Kidderminster. POPU entered the front garden and have removed and taken the property without the knowledge or consent of the owner. Offender/s made good their escape by unknown means, making off in an unknown direction

This **Burglary - Outbuilding** took place between 4/10/2017 20:00:00 and 04/10/2017 23:45:00 at **WOODBURY CLOSE, HARTLEBURY**

Between stated times, by means unknown, unknown suspect(s) have approached the offence location which is the IPs home address. Upon approaching the offence location, suspect(s) have proceeded to gain entry to the IPs detached garage which is approximately 150 yards away from the IPs house by cutting through a padlock and taking the bottom half of it off and also smashing the motion sensor alarm. Suspect(s) have then stolen a travel cot from inside the garage and then left the offence location with the travel cot

This **Burglary - Business And Community** took place between 12/10/2017 20:00:00 and 12/10/2017 23:30:00 at **M P B GARDEN BUILDINGS LTD, IKON INDUSTRIAL ESTATE, HARTLEBURY, KIDDERMINSTER,**

3 to 4 unknown persons have attended the premises cutting the chain to the compound and entered the site. Whilst there they have stolen £20,000 worth of wood, £1000 of doors, a £10,000 fork lift truck. Suspects have gone inside a unlocked shed within the compound and stolen a water cooler

This **Burglary - Outbuilding** took place between 10/10/2017 10:00:00 and 24/10/2017 10:00:00 at **WOODBURY CLOSE, HARTLEBURY,**

On the evening of 10th October into 11th October, offender(s) unknown have approached secure gate to rear garden and have cut through the hasp to allow access. They've then approached a secure garden shed and have cut the lock to allow access. Entry has then been gained and lawn mower and strimmer removed from within and left outside the shed. Some bolt croppers were left beside the tools believed to belong to the offender(s). Nothing was taken on this occasion and IP believes they may have been disturbed but nothing seen nor heard. The IP has repaired both locks but the same thing has happened again after the initial offence period. This time around, an alarm was fitted to

the shed and it is believed that this has triggered and scared off the offenders when they've forced open the shed door

This **Vehicle Damage** took place between 18/10/2017 10:00:00 and 27/10/2017 02:00:00 at **MOORS AVENUE, HARTLEBURY**

The IP was going on his holidays and on arriving at the railway station was unable to find a space to park; he therefore parked his vehicle, a purple Volvo V50, in a nearby road (offence location). Whilst the IP was away, he was contacted by the police as his vehicle was causing an obstruction and was parked on a private road. The IP was unable to do anything as he was away. On return from his holiday the IP discovered a post-it note on his vehicle saying 'private no parking' and also that the offside rear quarter panel had been keyed (18" line).
